

Program Overview:

The S.T.A.B.L.E. Program is designed for the Period following resuscitation of the newborn until care is transferred to the transport team. Presented by expert clinicians in a didactic/interactive format, S.T.A.B.L.E. is a concise, directive tool to help organize the myriad of details and interventions necessary to provide care to a sick or premature infant prior to transport.

Intended Audience:

Instruction is designed for general or intermediate-level hospital staff including RNs working in mother/baby units, labor & delivery, nursery, postpartum, ER, Nurse midwives; LPNs; Nursing Assistants; Physicians: pediatricians, family practice residents; Respiratory therapists; Pre-hospital providers.

Course Objectives:

- Review the purpose of the S.T.A.B.L.E. program.
- Identify the risk factors, symptoms and treatment options for hypoglycemia in the neonate.
- Describe the effects of cold stress on the neonate and appropriate warming measures.
- Review Blood gas analysis in the neonate.
- Identify and describe various respiratory issues in stabilizing the neonate for transport.
- Review symptoms of shock and appropriate therapies.
- Review signs and symptoms of sepsis.
- Discuss the interpretation of lab values in sepsis.
- Discuss emotional support for families.
- Discuss quality improvement measures.
